

Because good health is important, certain preventive care services received in-network are covered at no additional cost.

If you are enrolled in the Cigna medical health plan, you and your family may be eligible for some important preventive services at no additional cost to you, such as an annual preventive care well visit. Be aware that your plan can require you to pay some of the costs of the office visit, if the preventive service is not the primary purpose of the visit, or if your doctor bills you for the preventive services separately from the office visit.

Screenings considered preventive are listed below, as part of the Affordable Care Act. More information can be found [here](#). Screenings listed below are at no cost to you when delivered by a doctor or other provider in the [Cigna health plan network](#), or through [Wyoming Health Fairs](#).

- Blood Chemistry Panel
- Hemogram (CBC) with Differential
- PSA Screening for Men
- Thyroid Panel 1 (T3 Uptake, Total T4)
- Thyroid Panel 2 (Free T3 and Free T4)
- Hepatitis C Antibody
- Hemoglobin A1C
- Flu Vaccine
- Ferritin
- Vitamin D screening coverage is based on age and covered medical diagnosis.
